UPFRONT COSTS OF BUYING A HOME!

Binder:

Typically around \$1,000 or 1% of the purchase price. This is a deposit made to show the seller that you are serious about purchasing the home.

Home Inspection:

Averages \$450, depending on the size and location of the home. This inspection is crucial for identifying any potential issues with the property before finalizing the purchase.

Wood Destroying Organism (WDO) Inspection:

Can cost up to \$400. This inspection checks for termites and other pests that could cause significant structural damage to the home.

Appraisal:

Ranges from \$600 to \$1,000, depending on the property's size, location, and complexity. An appraisal ensures that the home's market value aligns with the purchase price, which is important for both you and your lender.
